Clovis Archaeology at the Gault Site, Texas

(May 16-May 21, 2010)

Join PCRG and the Gault School of Archaeological Research (GSAR) for a unique experience at the premier Clovis-age site in North America. Participants will meet at the Gault School on Sunday, May 16 and will spend five days excavating at the site. PCRG staff and members will spend three weeks working at the Upper Crossing site this season. During Session 1 we will investigate the Middle and Late Archaic deposits first encountered in 2009. Participants may sign up for either or both weeks of work. Session 2 will be devoted to mapping Late Prehistoric stone enclosures at several nearby sites. We encourage participants to arrive for their work session on Sunday and work through the week, although shorter stays are possible. We will camp adjacent to a Forest Service bunkhouse that is equipped with a kitchen and showers. Limited space (without hookups) is also available for trailers or small RVs.

High-Altitude Archaeology in the Uncompahgre Wilderness

July 13-July 19

This year PCRG will carry out a testing and survey project on a large, but poorly understood high-altitude site in the San Juan Mountains of southwestern Colorado. We will camp in the wilderness area, just below timberline, and hike up to the site each day. Participants should plan to meet the group on July 13 and work through July 18. Depending on weather, on July 19 participants may be able to climb nearby Uncompahgre Peak, one of Colorado's 54 14,000-ft. peaks.
